DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION REGARDING ITEM FOR INDIVIDUAL CONSIDERATION

Consideration of Plan amendment to provide same-sex marriage survivor benefits

Mr. Rohan stated that at the Board of Trustees meeting on February 12, the Board authorized, pursuant to Section 3.03(b) of the Plan, requesting an opinion of the Dallas City Attorney as to whether federal law required DFPF to provide survivor benefits to lawfully married same sex spouses. The City Attorney has provided this opinion for the Board's consideration. Section 9.01(i) of the Plan reads as follows: "The Board shall have the authority to amend this Combined Pension Plan to the extent necessary to assure that the Plan continually meets the qualification requirements of the Code or any other applicable Federal law." Pursuant to Section 9.01(i) such an amendment does not require approval by a vote of the members. The City Attorney was present to answer questions about his opinion.
