**RE: OPEN RECORDS REQUEST - MODIFICATION**

I am writing to you in your capacity as Legal Counsel for the Dallas Police & Fire Pension System ("the Pension System"), and pursuant to instructions set forth in the Pension System's letter to my attention of January 14, 2003 (copy enclosed).

In the aforementioned letter, the Pension System indicated that documents potentially responsive to questions 2, 3, and 4 of my Open Records Request of December 28, 2002, (copy enclosed) are stored offsite, and would require a search and retrieval to copy or compile. As such, please identify the storage box number(s), date(s) of storage, and complete contents of each storage box believed to contain the information responsive to the aforementioned Open Records Request, items 2, 3, and 4. Upon review, I will advise should I wish to incur the added cost of retrieval.

Finally, I remain unclear on the answer to question 1 of my Open Records Request of December 28, 2002, and, pursuant to the Texas Public Information Act, Chapter 552, Texas Government Code, again request an answer to the following question:

1. Included with its 2001 Annual Report as Year 2001 in Review (copy enclosed), the Pension System states that "*The System acquired a four-story office building situated north of downtown Dallas on North Akard Street at the intersection of Cedar Springs Road.*" Please provide the exact date on which the Pension System purchased the aforementioned four-story office building.
