On April 7, 2003, the Office of the Attorney General issued the aforementioned Open Records Ruling regarding the Dallas Police & Fire Pension System (the "System") that, among other things, stated the following:

- "Based on the statute, the attorney general expects that, within 10 calendar days of this ruling, the governmental body will do one of the following three things: 1) release the public records; 2) notify the requestor of the exact day, time, and place that copies of the records will be provided or that the records can be inspected; or 3) notify the requestor of the governmental body's intent to challenge this ruling in court."

During the now 23 calendar days since that time, the System has failed to do any of the aforementioned three things noted above. As the requestor of the information, I remain enthusiastic about the release of the subject public documents and, as such, respectfully request your immediate assistance in ensuring the System's compliance with instructions set forth on April 7, 2003, by the Office of the Attorney General.

I appreciate your assistance, and look forward to a timely resolution to this matter.
