Dear Mr. Chaney:

On October 4, 2001, both you and Councilmember Mitchell Rasansky were appointed to the Board of Trustees for the Dallas Police & Fire Pension System (the "System") ([Exhibit "A"](#)). During the first six months of the following year, both you and Councilmember Mitchell Rasansky resigned from the System's Board of Trustees, submitting letters of resignation that were essentially the same, both in style and content ([Exhibit "B"](#), [Exhibit "C"](#)).

Pursuant to the Texas Public Information Act (Texas Open Records Act), Chapter 552, Texas Government Code, please provide the following information:

1. Were you encouraged or otherwise forced to resign from the System's Board of Trustees? If so, please provide a description of the events and/or circumstances that precipitated your resignation. If not, please identify the issues as a member of the Dallas City Council that caused a "conflict of interest" with your appointed role as City Council Trustee of the Dallas Police & Fire Pension System.

Please advise should you have comments or require additional information. We appreciate your anticipated cooperation, and look forward to hearing from you at the earliest possible time.
