Gov. Abbott Appoints New Board Members

overnor Greg Abbott appointed new Board members to the Texas State Board of Public Accountancy (TSBPA) on October 3, 2019. Newly-appointed Board members include Kelly V. Aimone, Esq. of Houston; Kevin J. Koch, CPA of Temple; Debra D. Seefeld, CPA of Montgomery; and Joyce A. Yannuzzi of New Braunfels. The new members will each serve a six-year term and have replaced members with expired terms. We anticipate one more new Board member appointment from Governor Abbott in the coming months.

The *Public Accountancy Act* (the *Act*) provides for 15 Board members appointed by the governor, with the advice and consent of the Senate, for six-year staggered terms. Board members are required to be citizens of the United States and residents of Texas. Board membership is structured in the following manner:

- **8** must be licensed CPAs who are in public practice at the time of their appointments to the Board;
- **2** must be other licensed CPAs who may or may not be in public practice at the time of their appointments to the Board; and
- **5** must be public members who are not licensed under the *Act* and who are not financially involved in an organization subject to regulation by the Board.

The *Act* also provides, as does the enabling legislation of most licensing agencies, that the Board has the responsibility for policymaking and the executive director is responsible for the agency's day-to-day management and staff. The Board is statutorily empowered to regulate the practice of accountancy in Texas and may adopt rules as necessary to govern its proceedings, perform its duties, regulate the practice of accountancy in Texas, and enforce applicable law. The Board may act directly under its statute and rules or through the executive director or a Board committee.

Specializations Are Not Recognized by the Board

If you advertise or market your CPA services to the public, keep in mind that under Board *Rule 501.82*, "self-laudatory statements that are not based on verifiable facts" are not acceptable. The Board does not recognize specializations in the practice of public accounting. Accordingly, a CPA should **avoid the use of terms like "specialist**" or any variation as it implies recognition by the Board. Ratified at the September 19, 2019 Board Meeting
