Fee Decrease

Yes, you read the headline correctly. Effective September 1, 2021, the fee to renew your CPA license **decreased** from \$65 to \$60. The fee decrease applies to individuals. The Board is self-sustaining. All direct and indirect costs must be paid from what it collects in license renewal fees, firm registrations, exam fees, sponsor registrations, and other collections. ■

Fingerprint-Based Background Check Updates

Effective September 1, 2019, the **Texas Legislature enacted a law** requiring all **renewing licensees and non-CPA firm owners** to complete a state and national fingerprint-based background check. The Texas Legislature has previously mandated fingerprinting requirements for other licensed professionals such as doctors, nurses, architects, engineers, pharmacists, lawyers, and realtors. The deadline for fingerprint-based background checks for all Texas CPAs has been extended to September 1, 2022, as a result of the passage of Senate Bill 297. The bill was passed by both houses and was signed by Texas Governor Greg Abbott on June 7, 2021. As a reminder, all non-CPA owners in Texas firms also are required to complete the fingerprint-based background check by September 1, 2022.

Even though an extension has been granted, **don't procrastinate** and delay any longer than is necessary to complete this important requirement!

Simply follow the instructions on your account page (shown below) after logging into **Online Services** on the TSBPA website (<https://www.tsbpa.texas.gov/php/fpl/indsecentry.php>).

Your license fees have been paid and your license has been issued.

As of today (05/20/2021) your legislatively mandated CPA License Fingerprint Status is: **Need to be fingerprinted.**

In accordance with the 86th Texas Legislature and *Section 901.169* of the *Public Accountancy Act*, a new fingerprinting requirement has been added to the renewal process for your CPA license.

To schedule your appointment, simply visit [IdentoGO: 11J9GV - Texas State Board of Public Accountancy - Licensee](#) and follow the instructions.

The agency **Service Code** is **11J9GV**.

When prompted, please enter your unique **Agency Identifier: BP-L0#####**

Firms can check the fingerprinting status of non-CPA owners through **Online Services** (<https://www.tsbpa.texas.gov/php/fpl/firmsecentry.php>). After logging in, simply select 'Non-CPA Owners' under the VIEW heading of the firm's main menu.

Increasing the CPA Pipeline

National trends show that there is a disparity between the number of recent college graduates with accounting degrees and the number of new candidates sitting for the Uniform Certified Public Accountant (CPA) Exam. According to the American Institute of CPAs, about 1 out of 3 accounting graduates make it all the way to licensure. Also, data from the Social Security Administration shows that roughly 10,000 baby boomers are retiring each day.

The Texas State Board of Public Accountancy (TSBPA) has many efforts underway to foster the growth of the profession and fuel the CPA pipeline. The public interest is best served when CPA services are readily available. The Board's fifth-year scholarship program provided

3,589 scholarships totaling \$8,565,393.14 in scholarships over the past ten academic years (2011–2020). The scholarships aid disadvantaged students who need assistance financing a fifth year of college often necessary to meet the educational requirements to take the CPA Exam. Funds are allocated to participating Texas colleges and universities, whose financial aid offices make the decisions on providing scholarships to individual students.

The fifth-year scholarship program is funded by Texas CPAs who contribute a legislatively mandated \$10 fee to the scholarship program through their annual license renewal. The Public Accountancy Act (the *Act*) provides for the establishment and maintenance of the program. The Texas Legislature passed House Bill 2440 (81st Legislature Regular Session 2009) and Senate Bill 777 (82nd Legislature Regular Session 2011) transferring administration of the accounting scholarship trust fund for fifth-year accounting students to the TSBPA. No administrative costs are assessed by the Board to administer the scholarship program.

Additionally, TSBPA staff routinely meets with accounting students and faculty members at colleges, universities, and student auxiliaries to provide updated information on the CPA Exam and Board requirements. Important news alerts and announcements are also communicated to candidates via email blasts, the Board's website, and social media posts. When an individual completes the CPA Exam, they are sent an application for the issuance of the CPA certificate, along with instructions. One year following the completion of the Exam, a follow-up email is sent to individuals who have not been certified. Additionally, the Board by Rule, has an arrangement with four participating Texas community colleges to offer a complete accounting and business curriculum to meet the Texas education requirements for the Exam. Many individuals who decide to change careers to accounting take advantage of this program. ■



Employee Tenure in 2021

According to statistics from the U.S. Department of Labor, the median number of years that wage and salary workers had been with their current employer was 4.1 years in January 2020. The Texas State Board of Public Accountancy (TSBPA) has a total of 17 employees who have worked for the agency for more than 10 years and eight employees who have been with the agency for more than 20 years. We are a small agency with a total of 35 employees (we're hiring!) who work hard to serve a total of 81,993 licensees. 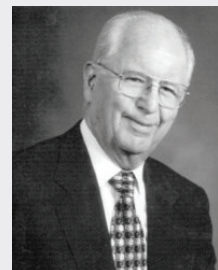

In Memoriam



Rowland D. Pattillo, CPA passed away at the age of 97 on November 29, 2020 due to COVID-19. He served on the Texas State Board of Public Accountancy from

1985 until 1991 and was treasurer from 1989 until 1990. He was chairman of the Behavioral Enforcement Committee and also served on the Constructive Enforcement Committee. Mr. Pattillo served on the Council of the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants and was past treasurer, vice-president, and president of the Texas Society of CPAs.

A native of Arkansas, Mr. Pattillo attended Arkadelphia High School, Henderson State Teachers College, and Ouachita Baptist College. He received a BBA in accounting with honors from the University of Texas at Austin and was a partner of Pattillo, Brown & Hill, L.L.P.
