Results of the 88th Texas Legislative Session

A result of the regular session of the 88th Texas Legislature, lawmakers and Governor Greg Abbott approved Bills that affect the Texas *Public Accountancy Act* and agency operations. You can view more details about each law by clicking on the Bill number. House Bill 2217

House Bill 2217 was signed into law by Governor Greg Abbott and went into effect on June 9, 2023. The Texas State Board proposed this legislation, which expands the scholarship for fifth-year accounting students to **all** Texas accounting students who have **completed 15 semester hours of upper-level accounting coursework**. The scholarship application and more information will be available on our website under the "Scholarship" tab. A special thanks to Representative Angie Button, CPA and Senator Charles Perry, CPA for sponsoring this legislation.

HB 2217 also made housekeeping updates to the Texas *Public Accountancy Act*, and most significantly, allows our Board members to serve for consecutive terms. This will assist our agency's mission to protect the public by ensuring that our volunteer-based Board is fully staffed with exceptional members who are dedicated to serving the public and the profession.

Effective immediately, the Board is now emailing license expiration notices in response to the passage of HB 2217. The Bill made amendments to *Section 901.404* of the T*exas Occupations Code*, which now reads as follows:

Sec. 901.404. NOTICE OF LICENSE EXPIRATION. (a) Not later than the 30th day before the expiration date of a person 's license, the Board shall send written or electronic notice of the impending license expiration to the person at the person's last known address or email address according to the Board's records.

(b) The Board shall determine the amount of the renewal fee and shall provide written or electronic notice of that amount to the person within the time provided by Subsection (a).

Senate Bill 510

Senate Bill 510 protects the privacy of Texas CPAs. Certain data such as electronic mail addresses, home addresses, and date of birth have been added to the list of information the agency is required to maintain confidential.

Senate Bill 159

Effective September 1, 2023, Texas CPA candidates will be allowed to take the CPA Exam with 120 total hours and a bachelor's degree, including no fewer than 21 semester hours of upper-level accounting courses.

Effective September 1, 2023, the **new education requirements** to be eligible **to take the CPA Exam** in Texas are as follows:

- 1. Hold a baccalaureate or graduate degree, or its equivalent as determined by Board *Rule*, conferred by a Board recognized institution of higher education;
- Complete no fewer than 120 semester hours or quarter-hour equivalents in Board-recognized courses, including no fewer than 24 semester hours of accounting or equivalent courses as determined by Board *Rule*, and within the 24 semester hours of accounting with no fewer than 21 semester hours of upper-level accounting courses as determined by Board *Rule*, including two semester hours of accounting/tax research and analysis;
- 3. Complete no fewer than 24 semester hours of upper level business coursework, including two semester hours of accounting/business communications coursework.

Effective September 1, 2023, the new requirements for CPA certification in Texas include:

- 1. Additional semester credit hours to attain a total of 150 semester hours;
- 2. Six additional semester credit hours of upper-level accounting;
- 3. Complete a three-semester hour, Board-approved ethics course.

Iffective immediately, the Board will exclusively email license expiration notices to licensees with email addresses on file. Mailed reminders will no longer be sent, unless the Board does not have your email address on file. Use Online Services on the Board's website to ensure your email and mailing addresses
are up-to-date and you receive important Board notifications. ■

Accounting Students Scholarships

he Texas State Board of Public Accountancy administers a scholarship program for accounting students attending participating Texas schools. In the 2022-2023 academic year, there were 245 scholarship recipients and a total of \$733,296 scholarship funds were awarded. The scholarships aid disadvantaged students who need assistance financing the coursework necessary to meet the educational requirements to take the CPA Exam. Funds are allocated to participating Texas colleges and universities, whose financial aid offices make the decisions on providing scholarships to individual students.

The scholarship program is funded by Texas CPAs who contribute a legislatively mandated \$10 fee to the scholarship program through their annual license renewal. The *Public Accountancy Act* provides for the establishment and maintenance of the program. The Texas Legislature passed House Bill 2217, which expands the scholarship for fifth-year accounting students to **all** Texas accounting students who are attending a participating Texas college or university and majoring in accounting and have completed 15 semester hours of upper-level accounting coursework (88th Legislature Regular Session 2023).



AGREED CONSENT ORDERS BEHAVIORAL ENFORCEMENT COMMITTEE

Respondent entered into an agreed consent order (ACO) with the Board whereby Respondent was reprimanded and assessed \$697.04 in administrative costs to be paid within 30 days of the date of the Board Order.

After defending a civil case successfully, on appeal, Respondent was found liable for over \$7 million in damages for his part in co-signing the approval of a credit request for a loan that turned out to be fraudulent while he was CFO of a local bank in Curacao. Respondent was not criminally charged; however, the CEO of the bank was convicted of fraud.

In addition, Respondents were assessed a \$1,500 administrative penalty and \$743.47 in administrative costs to be paid within 60 days of the date of the Board Order. Respondents prepared an inaccurate federal tax return. 3. Investigation No.: 22-02-10L Respondent: Ayotunde Oluwasegun Fadipe Hometown: Richmond, TX Certificate No.: 107601 Rule Violations: 501.90(4), 501.90(5) Act Violations: 901.502(6), 901.502(10), 901.502(11)

Respondent entered into an ACO with the Board whereby Respondent was reprimanded and his certificate revoked, however, the revocation was stayed and Respondent was placed on probation for three years from the effective date of this order. In addition, Respondent shall attend and participate in the Accountants Confidential Assistance Network, notify his employer of the Board Order, and pay \$779.16 in administrative costs.

Respondent was convicted of the felony offense of misuse of a passport and sentenced to three years of probation.

Respondent was sentence to five years of incarceration followed by five years of supervised release. If Respondent wins her appeal and the conviction is reversed, Respondent's certificate will be reinstated.

UNAUTHORIZED PRACTICE OF PUBLIC ACCOUNTANCY



Help Us Identify Unlicensed Individuals and Firms Offering Accounting Services

Over the last three years, the Board's Unauthorized Practice of Public Accountancy Program has identified more than **1,700** unlicensed individuals and firms claiming to be CPAs or offering accounting or attest services to the public.

Although this program has been very successful, we know that there continues to be false or misleading advertising. There are approximately 83,000 licensed CPAs in Texas who can help protect the public from individuals and firms misrepresenting their qualifications.

In addition, Respondent shall attend and participate in the Accountants Confidential Assistance Network (ACAN) and pay \$739.68 in administrative costs within 30 days of the date of the Board Order.

Respondent received deferred adjudication for the felony offense of solicitation.

The Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) found Respondent Woodward violated a rule regarding fraud in connection with the purchase or sale of any security when he purchased stock while in possession of material, non-public information. Respondent Woodward was denied the privilege of practicing before the SEC for five years and ordered to pay disgorgement of \$21,326.36 and civil penalties of \$21,326.36. 5. Respondents put the banking information of one client on another client's tax return resulting in a refund being deposited in the wrong account. Respondent failed to take responsibility for the error and assist the client in resolving the matter.

Respondent entered into an ACO with the Board whereby Respondent was reprimanded and assessed an administrative penalty of \$5,000 and administrative costs of \$784.97 to be paid within 30 days of the date of the Board Order.

Respondent entered into an Agreed Consent Order with the Public Company Accountability and Oversight Board (PCAOB). Respondent allegedly failed to disclose certain reportable events to the PCAOB on PCAOB Form 3, *Special Report*, on a timely basis.

Respondent was also placed on limited scope prohibiting him from performing U.S. Department of Labor audits for companies headquartered in Texas without a pre-issuance review.

Respondent issued audited financial statements for a 401(k) profit-sharing plan which failed to meet Generally Accepted Auditing Standards.

Continuing Professional Education Actions

The respondents listed below were not in compliance with the Board's continuing professional education (CPE) requirements as of the date of the Board meeting. Each respondent was suspended for the earlier of a period of three years, or until the respondent complies with the licensing requirements of the *Act*. Additionally, a \$100 penalty was imposed for each year the respondent continues to be in non-compliance with the Board's CPE requirements. The respondents were found to be in violation of Board *Rule 523.111 (Required CPE Reporting)* and *501.94 (Mandatory Continuing Professional Education)*, as well as *Section 901.411* (CPE) of the *Act*.
