- 1. Approved the Ashmore Emerging Markets Local Currency Bond Fund for a \$25 million investment. Authorized the Administrator to execute documentation, perform all necessary acts and exercise all appropriate discretion to facilitate a \$25 million investment in the Ashmore Emerging Markets Local Currency Bond Fund with funding being provided by a \$25 million reduction in the System's investment in the Ashmore Emerging Markets Debt Fund.
- 2. Authorized the Administrator to execute documentation, perform all necessary acts and exercise all appropriate discretion to facilitate a \$30 million commitment to the Oaktree Power Fund III.
- **3.** Received and filed reports and recommendations of The Townsend Group, real estate investment consultants.
- **4.** Approved the proposed construction funding for the proposal by CDK Realty Advisors and authorized implementation of the CIVITAS loan program, subject to final approval of the Administrator and legal counsel.
- 5. Received and filed the Plan amendment election update.
- 6. Received and filed the Group Trust's monthly asset allocation report, monthly unitization report, the performance report unaudited draft, and the unaudited statements of net assets available for benefits.

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- 7. Received and filed the report on legal issues.
- **8.** Received and filed reports on pension-related legislative issues.
- 9. Received and filed reports by staff and Board members on due diligence meetings, seminars and/or conferences attended.
