#### **Trustee Election Planned**

The 2007 Trustee election will be held this Spring from March 30 to April 9, 2007 to fill the two Fire Trustee positions and the Two Police Trustee positions that expire May 31, 2007. The Trustee positions which will be voted on are Fire Place 2, currently held by Gary Edge; Fire Place 3, currently held by George Tomasovic; Police Place 2, currently held by Steven Shaw; and Police Place 3, currently held by Rector McCollum.

### **Running for Office**

The filing period for applications will be from 8 a.m. February 26 until 4 p.m. on March 7. Any active Member who wishes to become a candidate in the Trustee Election must do the following:

- Personally pick up an application from the Pension System office, presenting your employee ID and Driver's License;
- Sign a form acknowledging receipt of the application and all attachments;
- Return the completed application to the Pension System office by 4 p.m. March 7;

and will not be finalized until later in 2007 when the final numbers are in for real estate and other illiquid assets.

Last year was busy, and we expect 2007 to be as well. I would like to discuss issues that we believe will be important in the next year.

First, our state legislature opened their session January 9, and will be in session until the end of May. Already a great number of bills have been introduced for the session. So far, none seems to target pension plans, but we will stay vigilant and notify members if one arises. The State Pension Review Board

will continue meeting quarterly during the year, and we will attend those meetings.

Second, we are always trying to identify new asset classes that might add value to the investment portfolio of the fund. This year, we have two in mind. They are Global Equities and Tactical Global Asset Allocation. Any new investment requires research. This research is a team approach between the Board, the staff, and the fund's general investment consultant. When the research is completed, the Board must make a decision on whether or not these make sense to our fund.

Third, the Board has approved and our I.T. Team is implementing the new web service program which will allow members to access their personal accounts and benefits. This will be implemented in stages and should be introduced by the end of Spring.

The Board and staff work diligently to make the fund one of the best, if not the best, in the country. As always, if you have any questions or comments, please feel free to contact any Board or staff member at any time.

## Dallas Firefighter is Finalist in Cook-off



Captain Rett Blankenship (Station 11, A-shift) has been selected as a finalist in the Tabasco Cook and Ladder Competition to be held February 6 at the Institute of Culinary Education in New York City.

Firefighters from across the country submitted original recipes for appetizers, soups, salads, entrées, side dishes or desserts. The judges chose the ten finalists, including Capt. Blankenship, who will be flown to New York to compete in the cook-off.

This will be Capt. Blankenship's second trip to the National "Tabasco Cook and Ladder Competition." He has also competed in several local and regional cooking contests.

After the recipe is completed, it will be judged on the following criteria: taste, appearance, originality, creativity, recipe clarity, and use of one or more Tabasco pepper sauces.

The first prize winner will receive \$10,000, with the second prize receiving \$5,000 and third prize \$2,000. Prize money is split evenly between the winner and his Firehouse.
