## Remembering C.J. "Jack" Liewehr (1944 - 2007)

**Web Member Services** is a dynamic, interactive site that not only will display your actual data from our computer files for your review, but use your file data to provide accurate "real-life" benefit estimates, DROP projections and other useful information. The target date for the launch is July 9.

This is only **Phase One** of the project. In the future we will add even more functionality and features to give you more flexibility in playing "what-if" games for benefit estimates—different retirement dates, percentage increases in pay, etc. We also plan to provide more "year-to-date" type of information.

Some of the terminology used may be different from what you are used to, and all beneficiary information is not yet available. We are working to clear up these details. In the meantime, we hope you enjoy the opportunity to use your real pension data to help you plan your retirement.
