Financial Planning

In addition to PREP, the Pension System now offers a class in Financial Planning. The Financial Planning seminar differs from PREP in that it focuses on financial planning issues and presents this information in more detail.

You will learn how to calculate your net worth, review your income sources, and set new financial goals. You also will learn about various investment instruments, such as bonds, stocks, and mutual funds, and learn how to read and interpret stock market information and other information to help you meet your investment goals. For post-retirement, you will learn about Medicare, Social Security benefits, long-term


care, survivor benefits, and estate planning. Finally, you will be briefed on health insurance and life insurance issues


Both PREP and Financial Planning training can be used for TCLEOS (Texas Commission on Law Enforcement Officer Standards) credit for Police Officers.


Registration


As of December 1, we are still in our Akard Street location, but soon, we will move to our new location at 4100 Harry Hines Boulevard.
